Friendly Frank



Requirements:

- \$15.00 - "Ground Breaker" Light set of Frankenstein (K-Mart)
- \$ 8.00 - 2 lengths of 8foot PVC pipe and angle joints and pvc pipe glue
- \$ 4.00 - Football Shoulder Pads from "Good Will"
- \$ 3.00 - 1 jumpsuit from "Good Will"
- \$30.00 - <- **TOTAL COST**

Tools Required:

- Saw (to cut PVC pipe)
- PVC pipe glue
- 2 feet of Duct Tape

How It Started Out:

After seeing the "Ground Breakers" monster lights for sale, the thought occurred to me that he would look great if he only had a body. I decided to build a quick body and I was pleasantly surprised at how well "Friendly Frank" came out!

How I Did It:

STEP 1

Lay out the jumpsuit on the ground with the rough pose you want "Friendly Frank" to have.

STEP 2



Build a roughly human shape out of the PVC pipe, measuring from the outfit "Friendly Frank" will be wearing. Remember to glue the PVC pipe pieces **INSIDE** the clothing, because you may have difficulty getting him dressed because his arms won't bend into the outfit!

STEP 3



Notice how I created his "feet", a rectangular base so that "Friendly Frank" can be a free-standing figure, I am working on a way to put on huge boots without him wobbling back and forth, when I do that I will update this page. As he stands right now, he is pretty sturdy.

STEP 4

Place the football shoulder pads in place to give "Friendly Frank" more bulk.

STEP 4



the "Ground Breaker" hands and Duct Tape them to the PVC pipe "arms"

STEP 5



Attach the "Ground Breaker" head to the body, (I used Duct Tape and Epoxy.)

Make sure you still have access to the underside of "Friendly Frank's" head so you can turn the lights on and off.

CONGRATULATIONS! Your done and he is ready to hang out and party!
