## bread clay



Left natural and covered with a sealant this makes good looking dead thing teeth. If made right bread clay is easy to mold and doesn't stick to anything.

### Needed Things

5 slices of white bread without their crusts (may need more bread )

3 tablespoons of white glue

A few drops of dish soap.

1 sturdy fork

A bowl to mix it all in

### The Process

Tear the crustless bread into small pieces and place in bowl. Add glue and one or two drops of dish soap and mix with the fork. If the mixture seems very sticky add more bread. Now get your hands in it. Mix and mash till you end up with a silky smooth workable clump of clay. It shouldn't stick or be sticky.

Bread clay is durable and can be worked paper thin. It does shrink a bit when drying. Store in a sealable plastic bag in the icebox. Can last unused for a few weeks this way.

To make teeth for your skull use the skulls teeth as a guide. Remember. No one is going to examine each prop. The TOTs don't care if it's not ultra realistic. They just care that it's there!
