## The fog chiller

The fog chiller is very useful if you have a fog machine. What this does is cools down you fog so it lasts much longer than normally. It can be either from 0 dollars to 20 dollars. It depends on if you have the materials.

Anyways lets get started

Materials:

- 1 bin or old cooler or anything close (must be quite big)
- Strong Glue or some kind of cocking
- Vent tubing or PVC piping

When you have all your materials start building.

- 1 - Cut a circular hole about the exact size of your cooler or bin. You may need a power saw for a cooler but for me it was an exacto knife because I had a thin bin.
- 2 - Now take your PVC or Vent tubing, and place it in the holes you cut. If you have flexible vent tubing then its a good idea to swirl it around a bit so that the fog takes more time to cool.
- 3 - Glue or Cock the PVC tubing or Vent tubing.
- 4 - Take your fog machine, Take PVC piping or vent tubing and place it on the nozzle of the machine. Or you could if you have a small fog machine or big Vent tubing you can place Fog machine inside tubing and Cover the back end of the tubing with a garbage bag.
- 5 -Your done! Weehee! Woohoo! Waahaa!



Now when your ready to put the haunted house up what you must do is fill it up with and then you put the top on the bin. This makes the fog stay more to the ground and the slowly rise up instead of the fog just going up very quickly. This project does not take long... Trust me!
