

## HOW TO PROJECT PAGE

This is a blast to do, and for the most part can add such a degree of Gore to your haunt it's amazing!!!

You can just about Corpse anything! it's so flexible



Here's a 4' Bucky Skeleton we did this year

Step 1 - Start with the basic Item;



Step 2 - Now cover the seams on his head using foil along worth a spray adhesive, such as 3 M etc..

Like foil highlights Eh?!!!!



Step 3 - Using your special Kit ordered through us, separate the Batting into many thin layers....then using the brush and a small amount of the special liquid latex, "brush in latex into the Batting until worked through. But not soaked!



Step 4 - Start applying the "sheets of Corpse Batting to your item, this is where your Artistic ability can come into play. Go wild, use your imagination!!

Step 5 - Cover your project in a way you see fit, if you want things to look like they're melting, then do so, if you want to make things "rot", well hey try that too.....



Now you must paint, I learned early on the Acrylic Paints adhere the best to Latex, so use them. 2 reasons, first (and best) they are cheap! Any craft store carry's them as well, so they are extremely easy to find.

Brown, dark greens, Dark Burgundy and Black/ Dark Grey's etc work well. You must experiment and see what you come up with, don't worry the Michelangelo in you will come out!



Step 6 - Finish it up!
