## Spooky Shadows



This display can also be performed from a front window as a silhouette on a white sheet or light colored opaque curtains or shades. One character can be sharpening an ax, or drinking a formula that turns him into a monster. Two characters can act out a struggle and murder. The wicked homeowner can use a prop of a trick-or-treater that he throws around. Use your imagination in developing a scary skit. You can also backlight these images with an old super 8mm movie, slide, video projector, or even cast shadows with other bright lights. Keep lights low outside. Consider using a strobe light for livelier shadowing.
