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## Alien-Pops Alien



### Requirements:

- - FREE - Alien-Pops display head
- - FREE - An old pair of rubber dishwasher gloves (turned inside-out)
- \$ 8.00 - 2 lengths of 8foot PVC pipe and angle joints and pvc pipe glue
- \$ 1.00 - Children's Football Shoulder Pads from "Good Will"
- \$ 3.00 - Aluminum Foil
- \$12.00 - <- **TOTAL COST**

### Tools Required:

- Saw (to cut PVC pipe)
  - PVC pipe glue
  - 2 feet of Duct Tape
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### **How It Started Out:**

I was at "Blockbuster" where I noticed that the Alien-Pops were on display in this pretty cool Alien head. There were only 3 Alien-Pops left and I asked the cashier if I bought the last 3 could I get the plastic head too. "Sure" she said. So now I got a cool plastic Alien head and the thought occurred to me that he would look great if he only had a body. I decided to build a quick body and I was pleasantly surprised at how well my "Alien-Pops Alien" came out! My plan is to place our trick-or-treat candy in the head and have the kids reach in and pull it out. (Of course, I will be watching so that kids wont get greedy and take more than one...)

### **How I Did It:**



#### *STEP 1*

Build a roughly human shape out of the PVC pipe. Notice how I created his "feet", a rectangular base so that "Alien-Pops Alien" can be a free-standing figure, I am working on a way to put on huge boots without him wobbling back and forth, when I do that I will update this page. As he stands right now, he is pretty sturdy.

#### *STEP 2*

Place the children's football shoulder pads in place to give "Alien-Pops Alien" more bulk. Duct tape the head to the pvc pipe frame and tape on a pair of rubber dishwasher gloves turned inside out.





**STEP 3**

Wrap the pvc pipe with aluminum foil.
