super easy "creepy sitting zombie!"



OK here is a step by step tutorial on how to make a super light poseable seated Zombie/ Dead guy...I haven't seen really anyone else create a body in this fashion, but its a really good way to do it, for a couple of reasons;

Materials:

- 1 - CHEAP!!!! did I mention that?
 - Chicken Wire \$9,
 - PVC \$4,
 - 1 Can Foam \$5,
 - Zombie head make yourself or buy \$29,
 - Clothes \$10

- TOTAL COST FOR THIS PROP \$57 TO BUY A PROP LIKE THIS IN A STORE ABOUT \$400

(PS YOU CANNOT EVEN FIND THINGS LIKE THIS IN CANADA!!!!!!)

Advantages:

- Pose able, place them anyway you want!
- Light weight, a whole 6' fig weighs about 6 lbs!!!! (perfect for pneumatics)
- easily fixable (if you need to)
- great base to place rotted clothing on!....
- Fairly quick to make....(about 2-3 hrs...) or spend 45min a evening spread over 3-4 evenings

OK the Zombie Body.....

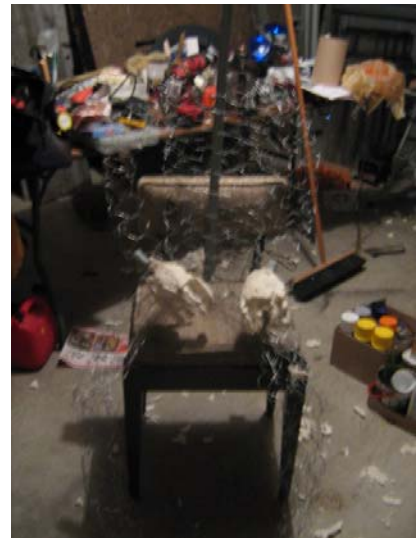


Hands!, what a Pain the the ass!!!!!! PVC Tubing with holes and Coat hangar wire.....
